

## Data Protection

### I. Privacy Responsibility

### II. General information on data processing

#### 1. Extent of processing of personal data

Our processing of personal data of our users is limited to the data required to provide a functioning website. The processing of personal data of our users takes place only for the purposes agreed with you or on the basis of a corresponding legal basis. Only those personal data are collected which are actually necessary for the performance and execution of our duties or which you have voluntarily provided to us.

#### 2. Your rights (data subjects)

You have the right to request information about your personal data processed by us. In particular, you may provide information about the processing purposes, the categories of personal data, the categories of recipients to whom your data has been disclosed or the planned storage period, the right of rectification, deletion, limitation of processing or opposition, data transmission, the source of your data if it was not collected from us and requires the existence of an automated decision-making process including an audit.

You also have the right to revoke any consent granted for the use of your personal data at any time. If you believe that the processing of your personal data by us conflicts with the applicable data protection regulations, you have the opportunity to complain to the Data Protection Office.

### III. Description and scope of data processing

#### 1. Visitor and usage data

Each time our website is accessed, our system automatically collects data and information from the computer system of the calling computer. The following data is collected here:

- Information about the browser type and version used
- The user's internet service provider
- The IP address of the user
- Date and time of access

The criterion for the duration of the storage of personal data is the respective statutory retention period. After the deadline, the corresponding data are routinely deleted, if they are no longer required to fulfill the contract or to initiate a contract. Storage is for data security reasons to ensure the stability and reliability of our system.

#### 2. Google Analytics

Our website uses "Google Analytics," a web analytics service provided by Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheater Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043 USA, to evaluate the website use. Google Analytics uses cookies that are stored on your computer. The information contained therein about the website and internet use of the visitor can be processed and evaluated by Google.

The data collected by Google may be transmitted by Google to countries outside the EU and the EEA, in particular the United States. However, Google has submitted to the Privacy Shield Framework. For more information on your rights, see

#### 3. Cookies

We use cookies on our website to make our offer user-friendly. Cookies do not harm your computer and do not contain viruses. Cookies are small files that your browser automatically creates and that are stored on your device (laptop, tablet, smartphone, etc.) when you visit our site. The cookies are stored until you delete them. This will allow us to recognize your browser the next time you visit it. If you do not want this, you can set up your browser so that it informs you about the setting of cookies and you allow them in individual cases. We point out, however, that disabling this will mean that you will not be able to use all features of our website.

The legal basis for the data processed by cookies is Article 6 (1) lit. f DSGVO.

#### **4. Contact form**

If you fill out a contact form or send us an e-mail or any other electronic message, your details will only be stored for the processing of the request or any other related questions and will only be used in the request.

The legal basis for the processing of your request is Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. b DSGVO.

We will delete your email address after completing your request.

To use the features of Google Maps, it is necessary to save your IP address. This information is usually transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States.
